(Lakewood, CO) The Pressed Fest, Colorado's classic cider tasting event, returns this summer with a new location and package sales available.

The Colorado Cider Guild is hosting the fifth annual **Pressed Fest** at the Heritage Lakewood Belmar Park in Lakewood, Colorado on Saturday, August 20th. There will be two sessions available – one from noon until 3pm, and from 4pm – 7pm.

Due to the popularity of on-site sales last year, the producers will be again offering package sales right on the festival grounds. Attendees can sample and then purchase their favorite ciders directly at the festival.
